However, individual Board members may be permitted to respond to criticism directed to them. Otherwise, the Board may direct that staff review the matter or ask that the matter be placed on a future agenda. The Fire District Board cannot discuss or take legal action on any issue raised during the Call to the Public that is not on the current Agenda, due to restrictions of the Open Meeting Law. Chief McMahan discussed that AZMAC compact is made into by jurisdictions within the State of Arizona to cope with emergencies and may require the assistance of other jurisdictions, possibly be reimbursed if declared a disaster situation, and that it is a cost recovery measure. A motion was made by Wayne Posey to approve the AZMAC and to allow for Chief McMahan to sign and execute the agreement, along with a second from Don Rountree.
